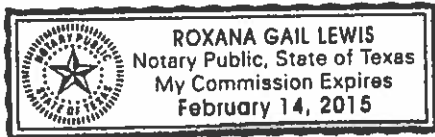
AFFIDAVIT


